

ADD HOME ANALYSIS RESULTS ON LEGAL PRECONDITIONS

ADD HOME presents the results of its analysis on the legal preconditions for a high quality accessibility of housing areas by sustainable means of transport!

During the first half of the project, the ADD HOME partners concentrated on analysing the legal frame conditions in transport and housing related laws and regulations. The survey focused on identifying barriers and support for creating housing areas with good accessibility for public transportation, cycling, walking and intermodal forms of transport. ADD HOME had a look in e.g. building and spatial planning laws, regulations for construction and reconstruction subsidies at national, regional and local level within the ADD HOME partners' countries.
